Substances restricted in RoHS and WEEE regulations

Products covered

All laminated sheet, tube and rod manufactured by the Attwater Group and all parts and components

machined from those materials.

Declaration

RoHS 2 restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic products: The

proscribed list contains four heavy metals (lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium) and two

brominated flame retardants (polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers

(PBDE)).

Directive 2015/863 of 31st March 2015, known as RoHS 3, includes 4 further substances in Annex II

(Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), Diisobutyl

phthalate (DIBP)).

The maximum allowed concentrations are 0.1% (except for cadmium which is limited to 0.01%) by

weight of homogenous material. Homogenous material means a material that cannot be mechanically

disjointed into different materials.

Attwater Group hereby declares that none of the products manufactured by the group utilise any of the

proscribed substances during their manufacture or subsequent processing.
